SEPTEMBER 10:

All school comes to the cafeteria for prayers and introduction of the RE Program

CLASS: Review Prayers, "Who's Who in the Church and Parish", Grace Before Meals, "God's Creation".

FIRST DAY Picnic and Games (Outside, Weather Permitting)

HOMEWORK: Complete "Who's Who" Worksheet

FAMILY TIME: Take a walk, list, and discuss, 5 things you see from God's Creation

CLASS:
